Cans *(Prior to recycling, please rinse thoroughly)*

- Aluminum cans (Example: soft drinks)
- Tin & steel cans ((Examples: soup & vegetable cans)

Paper *(Anything that tears)*

- Newspaper & all inserts
- Printing paper
- Junk mail
- Paper grocery & shopping bags.
- Magazines, phone books, paperback books (no hardcover books)

Cardboard *(Please remove contents & flatten boxes prior to recycling)*

- Corrugated (examples: moving & pizza boxes)
- Carton-Board (examples: cereal boxes, shoe boxes, beverage boxes)
- Frozen food boxes

Plastic *(Prior to recycling, please rinse thoroughly)*

- Any with recycle codes 1 through 7 (located on the bottom of the container)



Glass *(all colors of beverage containers)*

Unfortunately, at this time we cannot accept the following items:

- Contaminated Food Paper
- Tissue paper, hand towels, and toilet paper
- Plastic bags or Styrofoam
- Window glass, mirrors or light bulbs
- Ceramics (examples: plates, bowls and cups)
- Aluminum foil and trays

For your convenience, we have included a color guide of acceptable items to recycle. Please keep this for future reference and thank you for choosing Waste Management as your waste and recycling provider.
